CHAP Statement of Faith

The workings of a CHAP Membership

Your membership with CHAP starts the day you sign up and pay the membership fee. Membership is annual and requires renewal on or before the day of your original registration anniversary date. When you register as a CHAP Member, an email with a CHAP Membership Card will be sent to the email address you enter on the registration form. You can print the membership card and place it in your wallet to use as proof of your membership. If you sign up at the CHAP Convention, the convention admission discount will be deducted from your membership fee and an email with your membership card will be sent to the email address you supplied on the registration form.

If joining at any other time of the year, the CHAP membership convention discount will automatically be applied to the very next, and only the next, CHAP Convention. Discounts cannot be carried over. This membership gives you exclusive benefits; however the benefits are not guaranteed and may be changed at any time without notice.

A Remodeled Used Curriculum Sale

Our Used Curriculum coordinators have worked very hard to eliminate several issues from last year's Used Curriculum Sale in order to provide an opportunity for attendees to buy and sell used curriculum. Special Sessions for Support Group Leaders



These sessions are for past, present, or future support group leaders. The sessions are geared to help support group leaders in their position of leadership. Vendor Sessions

In 2010 CHAP introduced Vendor Sessions where you can learn about products and services sold by the vendors. The idea has been very well received and quite helpful to homeschool parents. The CHAP Convention is also offering two entertainment choices during the 2012 convention.

Family Entertainment

The first family entertainment choice is the final version of *IndoctriNation* (<http://indoctrinationmovie.com>) a Christian documentary which was shown in its draft form at last year's

Convention. The film is a 90-minute documentary that takes the audience on a panoramic exploration of one of the most important and controversial issues in the history of mankind, the issue of education. Traveling all over America with his family in a big yellow school bus and conducting a series of candid conversational interviews, Colin Gunn, a Scottish filmmaker, actor, and homeschool father of seven children living in Texas, is on a quest to discover the origins of our modern educational system. What he discovers is a masterful design that sought to replace God's recipe for training up the next generation with a humanistic, man-centered program that fragmented the family and undermined the influence of the Church and its Great Commission. Part documentary, part testimonial — a confessional and a rebuke, this film is above all a challenge and an encouragement to millions of Christians who need to know what history, experience, and the Scriptures have to say about what is perhaps the pivotal issue of our time: the discipleship and training of the next generation.

The second family entertainment choice is a video from the series Samuel E. Collins and the Search for Biblical Truth (<http://www.searchforbiblicaltruths.com>). From their website: "The Collins Family has the same convictions you do. That's why we created the DVD series Samuel L. Collins: The Search for Biblical Truths... we thought it was time that 6-12 year-old Christian children could finally have a role model who was an actual child from an actual family who dealt with real-life challenges from a biblical perspective. Like the old *Mission Impossible* TV series, Samuel Collins will be tasked by Special Operations Commander with a different mission each time. The differences? First, Samuel Collins doesn't look anything like Peter Graves! But, second, and more importantly, our hero is tracking down applicable biblical truth through several clues. In each episode, as we follow Samuel and his family around the globe — in one exotic locale after another — he will learn a different Christian principle based upon his Bible verse for the day.

CHAP is blessed to be offering the opportunity for attendees at the Convention to view either one or both of these entertainment possibilities free of charge. They will be shown both days of the Convention.

Farm Show Complex Information

No food or drink may be brought into the Farm Show Complex. Please be above reproach and respect the rules of the facility.

The Farm Show has several ATM machines inside the complex buildings and also a drive-up machine outside the Cameron Street Lobby. Please consult your complex map for exact location denoted "\$."

The emergency phone number for the Farm Show Complex during the hours of the Convention is 717-783-2815. This is an emergency number and not a number for information about the Convention. For Convention information please refer to the CHAP Convention website or stop by Booth #820.

Parking

Parking is available on-site for \$8 per vehicle. If the main lot becomes full, overflow parking will be available off-site for \$8 per vehicle in the parking lot at the corner of Elmerton Avenue and Sycamore Drive (watch for signs off I-81 and Cameron Street) and includes shuttle bus service to the Farm Show Complex. This parking fee is the Farm Show's required policy.

Accommodations

This year for your convenience we have secured blocks of rooms at various local hotels that awarded us reduced rates.

Solicitation Prohibited

No solicitation or distribution of material, polling, or interviewing is permitted at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex indoors or in the parking area during the CHAP Homeschool Convention. Violators will be prosecuted and asked to leave the Convention.

Wristbands

If you lose your wristband there will be a \$3 handling fee to replace it. For assistance, go to the Special Registration Area at the main entrance located in the Northwest Hall. Wristbands are nontransferable.

Children

The Convention is designed for parents to examine and purchase curriculum and attend seminars and workshops for encouragement, inspiration, and education. Childcare is not provided. The parents of children and teens attending the Convention must also be in attendance at the Convention. Children must be supervised at all times by a parent. Since seminars and workshops are being recorded, we would like to provide quality recordings without extraneous sounds. Children may attend seminar sessions – with a parent – as long as they are quiet. We would suggest sitting on an aisle, near an exit, in order to leave quickly if the child becomes noisy.

Nursing Mothers' Room

Facilities are available for nursing mothers, but baby-care products are not provided. Only very young children may accompany their mothers into the Nursing Mothers' Room

No Food or Drink

No food or drink may be brought into the Farm Show building by order of the Farm Show office. The Farm Show concessionaire will have a variety of food available in a Food Court – everything from a cafeteria line with multiple choices to fast food stands for a quick bite to eat. Prices can be similar to amusement park pricing. You are welcome to bring your own food to be stored in a cooler in your car, and there are also restaurants in the vicinity, but please be above reproach and respect the rules of the facility. (This is not CHAP's rule but the Farm Show's policy). We encourage you to bring a cooler for an afternoon picnic outside while you rest between workshops and the Exhibit Hall.

Audio Recording

Most of the sessions will be audio recorded – please refer to the audio order form toward the back of this program for this information. CDs may be purchased at the Convention Recording Booth at the Convention or after the Convention at www.CHAPonline.com. Personal audio and video recorders are prohibited. When picking up CDs you wish to purchase, please allow at least one hour after the last session.

Wheeled Vehicles

Strollers and small wheeled items for your shopping convenience are permitted. Wagons, tricycles, scooters, roller blades, etc., are not permitted.

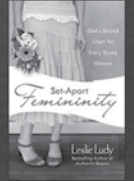

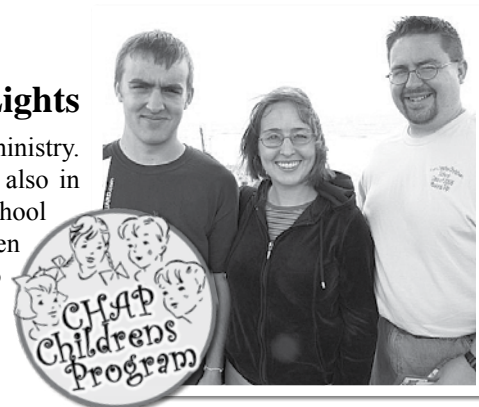


Jack Hubley

The Horror of the Flood!

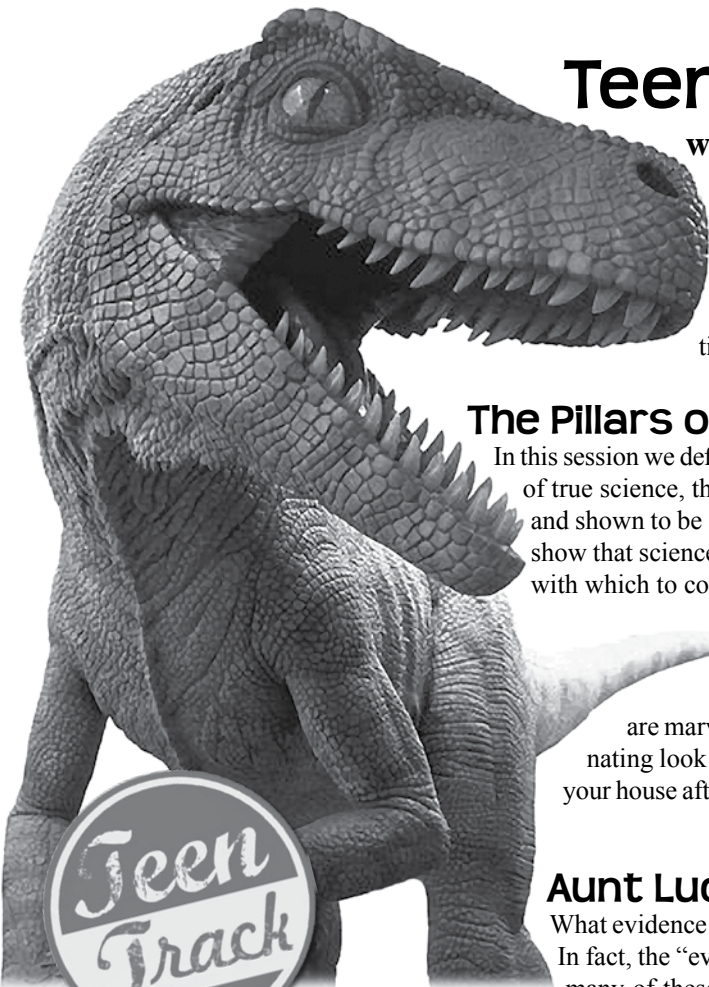

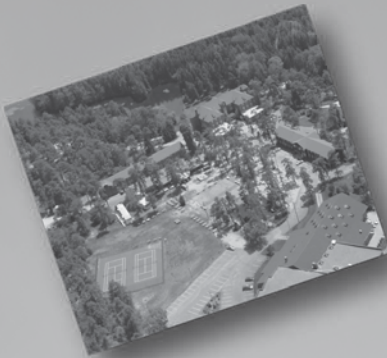

Dear Attendee,

CHAP is affiliated with the Alliance for Christian Home Education Leadership, which is a non-profit group that supports leaders serving leaders in the homeschooling community. Eight years ago it assumed its present name. The individuals associated with this group have met for over 20 years at an annual conference to share their expertise and insight on conducting homeschool conferences and to discuss the many issues homeschoolers face year round.

The Alliance

The Alliance represents 49 affiliate organizations from most of the states, Canada and Mexico and has over 1,000 years of cumulative homeschooling experience. Frequently leaders from other nations participate in our yearly conference and in other affiliate events. In addition, the affiliates are well connected throughout the year. These are all non-profit, fully Christian groups that have a statement of faith reflecting historical and biblical truth, and bylaws that ensure perpetual Christian leadership for these groups. In fact, these are requirements for non-profit organizations to associate with the Alliance. However, anyone may attend any of our state conventions as no membership is required to do this.

Homeschooling has grown so much that it is now a viable market. These groups have quietly served the homeschooling communities in their locales for many years, bringing wonderful conferences to the homeschooling community. The proceeds of these non-profit organizations are used to serve the people in their locales after the conferences are over. The boards of these organizations have diverted very little if any money to marketing. Instead, they use the proceeds to help support groups, assist with efforts to keep homeschooling freedoms alive and well, and support the homeschooling community with viable information about homeschooling in their locales and beyond.

American Home Education and Discipleship Conferences (AHEAD)

However, as the winds of change have brought homeschooling to the marketplace, we have seen advent of for-personal-profit homeschooling conventions. As you might expect, these have had an adverse effect on many of the non-profit conferences associated with the non-profit state homeschool organizations. God alone knows what is in store for any of these organizations, but without the support of the homeschooling community in their states, there is some risk that their ministry to

homeschoolers will diminish, as it has in some cases, or be lost altogether. The for-personal-profit conference organizers leave once the vendor hall is empty. The state specific non-profit boards are just beginning their work to assist homeschoolers in their locales when their conferences end. As you choose a conference to explore homeschooling and purchase curriculum, we hope you will consider the long-range questions of homeschooling and support the non-profit, specifically Christian conferences associated with the Alliance. These are called the **American Home Education and Discipleship Conferences (AHEAD)**.

These conferences seek to honor their stated Christian beliefs by having vendors and speakers that reflect those convictions. AHEAD see the call to Christian Education as one of their highest values, and leave the question of alternative belief systems in the hands of parents, rather than in the vendor hall per se.

Very early in the spring of 2010, the Alliance announced to the public its collective name for these 49 loosely associated, but solidly Christian homeschooling conferences, as mentioned above: **American Home Education and Discipleship Conferences**. As we already exist and have been serving the homeschooling community as a collective group for roughly 20-25 years, we have decided to make our history known and work together to educate the homeschooling community and others about one of the best known secrets in the realm of educating and discipling children at home.

CHAP is associated with **American Home Education and Discipleship Conferences**. We thank you so much for your patronage and trust you have been blessed by participating in the CHAP Homeschool Convention and other services CHAP provides year round.

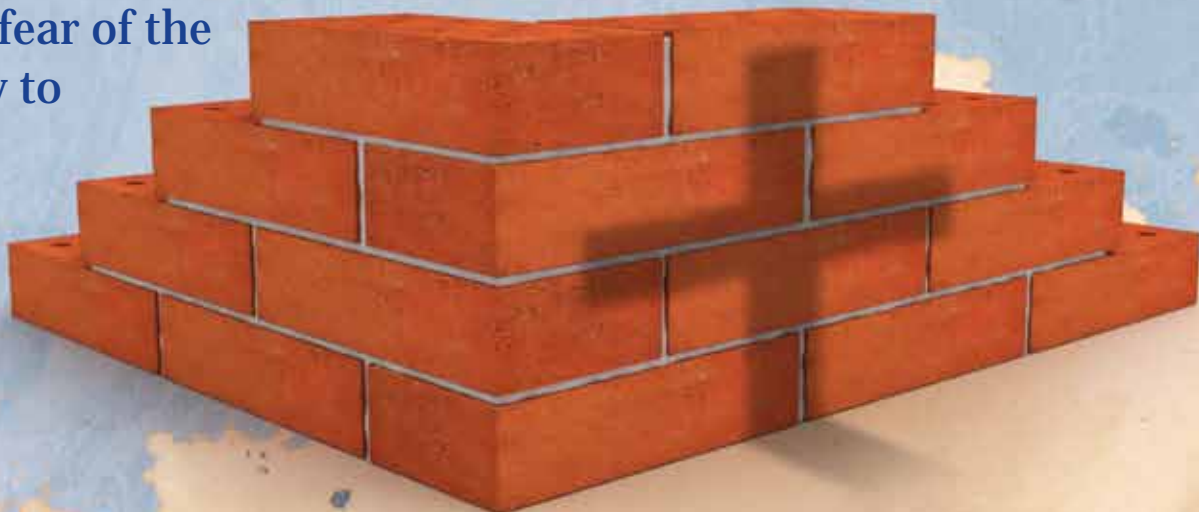
